Called a "Standard Oval", this mark dates to the 1930's. Red Wing Potters and Their Wares pictures this on page 146. Slight variant of this #7 in included to the right.



Here's a (very subtle) variant of the "Standard" #7 oval. Notice the left side of the top horizontal line extends to just under the "R" in "Red Wing". In the #7 pictured right the same line extends only to the middle of the "E" in "Red Wing"; this mark dates to the 1930's.



Known as a "Union" oval.



The #8 oval used in the 1930's.
