Top Row Left to Right:

Southwest Red Wingers: 2009 Blue Band Pitcher

29 regular + 1 special produced

This piece is 2/3 the size of the original 1982 National RWCS Cherry Band mug in a blue gray color. The regular pieces had a 1" red wing on its front side with the chapter logo on the opposite. The special had red and blue sponging around the top and bottom cherry bands.

Wolverine Chapter: 2010 "Minnesota & Michigan Little Brown Jug"

23 regulars produced

This is a replica of the jug that is passed by the University of Minnesota and University of Michigan—awarded to the winner of the football match up. The original jug features the scores of the past 90 meetings of the two teams. The colors of the M's are the original colors of the jerseys.

Iowa Chapter: 2010 15 Gallon Salt Glaze Crock

170 regulars, 5 specials

This commemorative is a replica of a 15 gallon salt glazed lily crock with advertising from P.C. Murray & Co. Fine Liquors, Dubuque – Iowa. The five specials were decorated: three with stamped lilies, One with two Cobalt blue birds, and one with Cobalt blue vines.

Wisconsin Chapter: 2009 Stoneware Pig Brown

56 regular + 3 specials produced

This commemorative is in the style of the Red Wing Stoneware pigs, which were available in Albany slip. The specials were all white, half white and half brown, and white with brown spots.

This vase was made in the style of Red Wing Art Pottery vase 894. The regulars were available in green and the specials were white.

Bailed jug with "The Otto Kuehn Preserving Co. Topeka, KS" advertising. The chapter logo is featured on the back and bottom stamped by the potter. The specials were available with black advertising stamp and featured one in blue sponge and the other with an Albany top and white bottom.

Cannon Valley Red Wing Collectors Club: 2009 Stenwick Indian Ashtray

70 regulars + 6 specials produced

This commemorative is a replica of the Chief Red Wing ashtray produced by the Red Wing Potteries. The regulars were available in the Albany slip glaze and the specials were glazed: 3 blue, 3 red, and 1 with two heads available with red glaze.

Sunshine State Redwingers: 2010 Red Wing Chicken Drinking Fount and Butternilk Feeder

22 regulars produced

Red Wing Stoneware began producing chicken feeders in the early 1900s and the RWCS also produced this piece in 1993. It features the chapter logo and "Red Wing Chicken Drinking Fount and Buttermilk Feeder".

Gopher Chapter: 2010 Crescent Creameries Stoneware lid

60 regulars + 15 specials produced

The original lid was dug out of the Red Wing Pottery dump. It features the Crescent Creamery trademark and the chapter logo on the back. The regulars are Albany slip and the specials are the same size and decoration but were 5 each - green, red and blue- glaze.

The spoon rest features the chapter logo and their bottom stamp in the handle. Three of the specials have a blue band at the rim and the other 3 have blue sponge around the rim.

50 regulars + 5 specials produced

The beater jar features advertising "Compliments of Churchill and Amery, Big Timber, Mont." The chapter features advertising from Montana and North Dakota. The specials had a blue tint on the top and bottom similar to the cherry band pitchers.
