- VOTING: General RWCS membership in attendance at the Annual Convention votes for People's Choice. Voting will begin Thursday, at 5:30 pm., and end Friday, at 3:20 p.m. A team of judges appointed by the Display Committee will vote for Best-Of-Show using the following criteria: a) quality of pieces (for as common or rare as they may be), b) representation and relation of types of pieces, c) related props, etc. that enhance display, and d) educational value/materials.
