Keynote Speaker: Wisconsin Stoneware

Dozens of stoneware/earthenware factories operated in southern Wisconsin from the 1840's until the 1870's. This presentation will focus on about a dozen of potteries located in cities like Milwaukee, Sheboygan, Menasha, Berlin, Wautoma, Portage and Whitewater. It will cover the owners and potters who ran them and the products they made.

Peter Maas, has collected and researched Wisconsin bottles and stoneware for over 40 years. He is a lifelong Milwaukee area resident and is a member of the Milwaukee Antique Bottle and Advertising Club.
